> is it possible to convert the type of an array contained in a structure?
>
> IDL> help , test.data
> <Expression>  INT      = Array[23]
> IDL> test.data=float(test.data)
> IDL> help , test.data
> <Expression>  INT      = Array[23]
>   ^^
> No Error, but still an INT_ARRAY
```

If the structure field is a pointer, it is. :-)

In fact, this is pretty much the *reason* for pointers in IDL. Because otherwise, objects (read named structures) would have had no chance of working, since you would never know ahead of time what was going to be stored there.
