I think this is a different problem.

For me at least, IDL experiences this problem even if I run it from X11.app. The bus error also only occurs with the use of the TV command, while PLOT and HELP, /DEVICE perform correctly.

My \$DISPLAY appears to be set correctly, and really must be since I see the output of PLOT.

It would appear to have something to do with X, because I can use the TV command to write to a PostScript file without incident.

I just wanted to acknowledge you all. Last night I too ran into the idl crash problem "bus error" problem when invoking tv or tvscl in idl 6.4 with set plot, 'x' also invoked. Changing to set plot, 'ps' or 'z' did not cause tv to make idl crash. Invoking atv or iplot also caused the "bus error". I was using an Xterm. I note also that the idlde.app and IDLDemos.app also crashed (without saying why).

The above update to X11 described by Raul fixed the problem.
