> I was using a program someone else had written to save my image to a
> GIF. It's been working great so far, until I got an error on one run.
> I tried running it again, and everything works great except now
> there's a blue arrow next to the line that originally had the error.
> Also, every time I run another program within IDL Workspace, the
> editor automatically redirects itself to the line the arrow points to.
>
> The program runs fine, all my other programs run fine, but I can't
> seem to get rid of this blue arrow. What does it mean, and how can I
> get rid of it?

This is a bug in early versions of the Workbench. You
can get it to go away by closing the window and opening
it again. Or, (my advice) you can just ignore it. :-)
