I have a string x

X STRING = '*280 948 80 0'

which I am trying to read into variables:

READS, x, stage, lat, lon, wind, press, format = '(A1,I3,1x,I3,1x,I3,1x,I4)'

This returns % Type conversion error: Unable to convert given STRING to Float.

and the problem seems to be the (ASCII decimal 42 mapped -) * symbol.

I have tried to read it into various formats (replace A by I or F for instance), but none works.

Has anyone got an idea, why that is and how to work around it?
