In addition to the COLOR keyword on the DEVICE command, you also need the BITS_PER_PIXEL=8 keyword set:

Set_Plot, PS Device, COLOR=1, BITS_PER_PIXEL=8

You might want to investigate better ways to set up your PostScript device, or sooner or later you will run into other archaic oddities.
