The proximate cause of the problem is that the Vizier database changed their text output so that column names were returned even when there was no data. This fooled queryivizer.pro into thinking there was data present when there really wasn't.

The distal cause of the problem is that I am too lazy to figure out how to parse the XML output from the Web query. Instead I keep using the plain text output, and thus I am (more) at mercy when they change their output text format.
