My homegrown widgets look different under OpenWindows than under Motif. Under OpenWindows each widget has a frame around it. Under Motif, there are no frames. I set the keyword frame=0 as often as I can, but I can't get the extraneous frames to go away. With nested widgets, the frames take extra room and clutter the widget. Is there some Xresource I can set to eliminate these frames under OpenWindows? An example is

```
base = widget_base(/column,frame = 0)
row = widget_base(base,/row,frame = 0)
donebutton = widget_button(row,value='DONE',uvalue = 'donebutton')
helpbutton = widget_button(row,value='HELP',uvalue = 'helpbutton')
widget_control,base,/realize
```

Under Openwindows I get frames, like this:

```

I want to eliminate the frames. Does anybody know what I'm doing wrong?
