Hi,

I am having trouble with my IDL\_PATH defined in my .bashrc.

Here is how it is defined:

IDL\_PATH="+\${my\_path}/idl/:+/home/jim/lib/IDL/:<IDL\_DEFAULT >+/home/bob/routines/:"

export IDL\_PATH

Then it points to 3 directories ( my IDL, jim's IDL and bob routines'). Note that "my path" is correctly defined before because wherever i am, i can call routines stored here.

The thing is that when i add a new routine in \${my\_path}/idl/ and i want to call it from another directory, i get the message: "Attempt to call undefined procedure/function" whereas it is well located in {my\_path}/idl/....

Does anyone know what goes wrong? Thanks.
