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Hi all,

I have a function declaration with both positional and keyword parameters like this:

```
FUNCTION WR_subtract, imga, imgb, WARP_DEG=wdeg, SKY_STYLE=skyst, $  
    SCALE_STYLE=scast
```

...and in another procedure I call the function like this:

```
interp_res =  
wr_subtract(intrp,civ,warp_deg=3.,sky_style=1,scale_style=1)
```

However, that function call gives me a syntax error when I try to compile:

```
interp_res =  
wr_subtract(intrp,civ,warp_deg=3.,sky_style=1,scale_style=1)  
                                     ^
```

% Syntax error.

Why the error??
