Thank you for your quick answer but this function "opens an existing EVF and returns the EVF ID, which is used to access data from the file using ENVI_EVF_INFO and ENVI_EVF_READ_RECORD"

I don't to access its content (I create the file), but I want to display it.

What I would like to do is the same exact task performed by an interactive "File>Open Vector File" in ENVI, which adds your vector data into the "Available Vectors List".

Then, I would to load this layer to a display of my choice. All is batch mode of course.
