It says "Callable IDL lets you call from other applications using windows DLL, Mac AppleScript or Unix sharable object library techniques. This way the idl libraries can be called directly."

On further investigation it is said. "Callable IDL is not documented in the standard IDL documentation set. For availability of callable IDL documentation call Research Systems."
