To answer my own question:

ITTIS Support tells me that there is a bug in the iTools that will be fixed in the next release.

The bug basically makes it impossible to use the freehand rotate tool to rotate a visualization. (For me the 3-D rotation is the main reason to use the iTools.)

I may be the only person who actually uses the iTools, but if you do, I recommend that you keep your IDL 7.1 installation until this bug is fixed.
