Hi,

I hesitate to give the easy answer, but what the heck. IDL can do string math so the following works a treat.

```
dateString = '970625'  
newDateString = '19' + dateString
```

But if you really need to do date math then you need to split the string into a 2-digit-year, a month and a day using STRMID. Add the century (1900) to the 2-digit date. Then you run the while thing JULDAY before doing math on it.
