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I think there are some Tricks for this callable IDL

1. You can not call a IDL subroutine from you program at VMS/AXP version and Window Version, but you can call your C or Fortran Program from IDL, this is ONE WAY callable.
 2. You can only run IDL server on UNIX system, may be this server allow you call idl subroutine for you C or Fortran program ?
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
