Hi all,

I was just wondering if anyone else would find it useful to have the ability to store !null as elements in otherwise homogenous arrays. Wouldn't this be a much more elegant way of encoding missing data than using NaNs? Of course, a lot of functionality would have to change - like, for example, one would have to be able to do

```
IDL> print, 3 + !null
3
```

instead of what actually occurs:

```
IDL> print, 3 + !null
% Variable is undefined: <UNDEFINED>
```

However, writing this post is worth it just to include that tautological error message.
