Hi folks,

if someone wants to use GPULib and Envi 4.8 commonly, then I have an installation hint for you (which mostly of you will know). On my Windows 7 x64 machine I have to change (or to set) the path variables from:

IDL\_PATH = +C:\Program Files\Tech-X\GPULib to: IDL\_PATH = +C:\Program Files\Tech-X\GPULib;<IDL\_DEFAULT>

as well as from:

IDL\_DLM\_PATH = +C:\Program Files\Tech-X\GPULib\lib to: IDL\_DLM\_PATH = +C:\Program Files\Tech-X\GPULib\lib;<IDL\_DEFAULT>

As Michael stated here (https://groups.google.com/group/comp.lang.idl-pvwave/browse\_thread/thread/89a871c7693bd71e/070b65fe34f70c3 b? hl=de&lnk=gst&q=gpulib#070b65fe34f70c3b) there is a preferences hierarchy. These path variables are not set by an ENVI 4.8 installation, so it's important to give IDL and ENVI the specific directories in the same hierarchy level since GPULib won't work properly if these setting were not made.
