I have started using a code base that requires a batch file to set variables, and start up IDLDE under windows 7. IDL> help,!version \*\* Structure !VERSION, 8 tags, length=104, data length=100: ARCH STRING 'x86 64' 'Win32' OS STRING OS FAMILY STRING 'Windows' OS NAME STRING 'Microsoft Windows' RELEASE STRING '8.0' BUILD DATE STRING 'Jun 17 2010' MEMORY\_BITS **INT** 64 FILE\_OFFSET\_BITS INT 64

However, for some reason, this causes IDL to crash on startup most of the time (about 80%). IDL has the splash screen come up, then start the progress bar that goes about 20% across, then it is gone - nonresponsive.

The batch file is quite simple, it set's some environment variables, then executes "start idlde".

I can see no material difference in starting IDL in this batch command, or 'normally' from the icon. The same env variables are set, I then execute the same startup routines.

Is this a known problem? any ideas on how to go about fixing it? Does this require a bug report to be filed?
