
Subject: TITLE property using object graphics

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I'm guessing I'm missing something simple. Being an old-school IDL programmer I've decided to explore a bit of the object graphics functions. I immediately ran into a problem just cutting and pasting from the help file examples. Here's an example:

```
theory = SIN(2.0*FINDGEN(200)*!PI/25.0)*EXP(-0.02*FINDGEN(200))
```

```
p1 = plot(theory, title="Test")
```

When doing so I get an error message: "PLOT: Graphics window does not exist".

If I just do the plot with no title it works fine. If I then try:

```
p1.TITLE = "Test"
```

I again get the same error message. If I "Print, P1" it gives me a list of the properties; TITLE = <NullObject>

So what's up?
