Hi,

I'm trying to do some matrix division, something which in MATLAB is done

$$r = a \backslash b$$

where A is m row x n column and B is an n column matrix and the result is and m x 1 column matrix.

I think this is called left matrix division and is equal to "b⁽⁻¹⁾ times a", but am having trouble inverting B as it is a column vector. I have been looking into IMSL_INV as I have not found any other IDL functions that claim to invert a matrix or do matrix division.
