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I am having a problem with CURSOR. When I plot something in a window, plot something in another window, and then attempt to get the value of a point in the first window, I get the value of the corresponding point in the second window. Is there a way to recover values from the first window without replotting?

I'm seeing this in IDL 6.4 and 8.1.
