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i've installed IDL 6.0 on a 64-bit Windows 7 and it does not run due to a FLEXlm error: -103,577. When I run Server Diags on LMTOOLS i get:

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The IDL6.0 licence, FLEXlm and Windows7 have problems since the system thinks IDL is running as a remote terminal, even when running XP virtual mode, and so you're only allowed the demo mode. Only solution i found to this problem is to install XP on the machine directly and run IDL6.0 on that. Seems to work just fine then.
