I've been down this road before, too, since in the end I discovered it is because Map_Proj_Init puts the wrong coordinates in the uv_box of the map structure it creates.

This is a long-time mission of mine to get this corrected, since it effects map projections created with the new mapping software in IDL 8.x, too (all that software rightly uses Map_Proj_Init to set up map projections), but no one seems to want to work on it. :-(
