- > Basically, the program is an interactive wrapper to cgPlot
- > and is called \*exactly\* like cgPlot, with all of cgPlot's
- > keywords, etc.
- >
- > IDL> cgZPlot, cgDemodata(1), PSym=2, Color='red'
- >
- > The operations are simple. Zoom with the LEFT mouse button and
- > pan with the RIGHT mouse button.

I have just added an UNDO capability to this program, that is arbitrarily set to 50 undo operations.
