if I have

0.003508

I want to return

3508

I have been playing with the format codes and strsplit but nothing has worked quite right. I am thinking I could write a little program to feed the number into a string array and run a few steps on the array such that once the array value no longer equals '0' or '.', it stops and returns whatever is left. However, before I go down this road, I thought it might be wise to ask if this is the best/only way to do it.
