Is there a way similar to AXIS to actually draw an tilted axis with a given angle and position? It would come with all the ticks and labels tilted in the right way.

Basically, I have a correlation of two decaying chemicals and I am trying to label the correlation line so that I am able to give a ruler of the aging on the plot.
