This contains our time stamps:

```
t=[0, 3, 6, 9, 33, 35, 36, 54, 55, 59, 93, 97, 100]
```

Create an offset vector:

```
d=SHIFT(t,1)
```

```
PRINT, t(WHERE(ABS(t-d) GE 5))
```

```
0      33     54      93
```

This gives the first element after a time gap.
