> Just upgraded to IDL 8.2.1 on my Ubuntu. First impression is positive,
> since the command `IDL> p = plot(INDGEN(10))` doesn't crash IDL down as it
> was doing in IDL 8.1.
>
> I tried to install the SVN toolkit and it worked as usual. However, when
> I restart the workbench, IDL asks me again wich connector I want to
> install, as if the toolkit didn't install at all. If I ignore this and
> try to open a repository location, I get:
>

> Selected SVN connector library is not available or cannot be loaded.
> If you selected native JavaHL connector, please check if binaries are
> available or install and select pure Java Subversion connector from the
> plug-in connectors update site.

> Window->Preferences->Team->SVN->SVN Connector.
