Hello all,

I'm really having a hard time reading tif images. I have extracted a tif image using ENVI software. Then I imported this really huge tif image (4526,12879,7) into IDL using 2 different ways; The one I used is importwizard to import this image into IDL as a variable. In this case, the following info is displayed on the locals window. The type of image is STRUCT, value is ANONYMOUS. What does this info tell me? Does it mean this image wasn't read?

The other one is to use read_tif command. In this case, I get "variable is undefined: READ_TIF. Execution halted at: \$MAIN\$". Then I checked if the file exists in a folder by file_test command like this, ok=file_test('D:\tmp\temp_opp\tmp_exam.tif'). It gave me 1. It exists in a folder. So what is the problem? Variable is undefined.
