I'm probably too late but is there a chance for following SVN bug to be solved in 8.3?

The bug is strange, and is reproducible on Windows and Linux.

1. Install SVN on a fresh IDL workbench
2. Checkout any project from SVN as a new project in the workspace (the coyote lib for example)
3. Right-click on the new project in the explorer: there is no IDL project properties tab! (this tab is useful because one has to check the box "update IDL path when project is opened or closed")

Workaround is: open any file in the project, modify it and save it. Then the tab appears!!!
