- > with IDL. Perhaps once ELF is more standard in Linux they will
- > be able to provide this.

From speaking with the tech reps at RSI, it sounds as if the problem was a lack of a dynamic linking standard for Linux. I was told that callable IDL and dynamic linking will be supported when a mainstream ELF distribution is available.

- > I also asked about when Linux will get the "real" license
- > manager, and he didn't know. Right now you must use the old
- > genvet type license, since the third party who does the IDL
- > license manager hasn't ported to Linux yet.

I believe Caldera has announced a port of FlexLM, which is the IDL licence manager. I don't know it's status.
