What version of IDL do you have?

From Lajos's reply it would appear you have a netCDF4 file - which uses HDF5 to handle the hard stuff that classic netCDF couldn't.

Newer versions of IDL "understand" netCDF4. So, if you have an old(er) version of IDL, that may be your problem. (If, indeed, it isn't what Lajos indicated - you are trying to read a regular HDF5 file)

I use the IDL netCDF browser to read netCDF3-and-4 datafiles with no problems.

In general, HDF5 and NetCDF-4 are the same. IDL's HDF5 library can be used for accessing and reading NetCDF-4, so you could try using IDL's H5_* routines and using the file as if it was NetCDF4.
