I think that you should update your code. IDL has abandoned round parenthesis for arrays ages ago. Try dropping those round ones for square ones: myArray[pos] = ...

That should bring you a step further. If not, let us know...

PS: round parenthesis are used for functions, so compile and programmers tend to get confused. That's why things should be kept like () for functions and [] for array indexing. Check the IDL help for compiler options.
