> I'm writing a program where I simultaneously display multiple images  
> of the same object in separate windows. The images are from different  
> imaging modalities, and they are properly aligned with each other. My  
> problem is this; when the cursor is in one of windows, I'd like to  
> display the cursor symbol (+) at the same position in all the windows,  
> and I'd like the multiple cursor symbols to move smoothly together  
> when I move the mouse. Has anybody done this, or have any suggestions?

Read the real cursor in one window and draw a "fake" cursor in the other  
windows with PLOTS and graphics mode of XOR.
