- > On startup, my draw widget is empty; the user is requested to load an
- > image file as the first operation.
- >
- > If, however, you inadvertently move the cursor over the draw widget
- > ("Define ROI" button, which calls CW_DEFROI, has _not_ been clicked),
- > IDL immediately exits with the message
- > "Variable is undefined: VALUE"
- > As I said, when you try IDL's example procedure for CW_DEFROI, you will
- > see the same reaction. - Any way to avoid this ?

The example for CW_DEFROI given in the on-line help facility for
IDL/MSWindows Version 4.0.1 worked without errors on my PC.

Possibly, the problem you encountered, is specific to the
platform - or you tried out another example.

Further analysis would be facilitated if you could send the
source of the erroneous program.
