If I understand you correctly, what you need to do to save the current color table with the image to the tiff file is:

```
IDL> tvlct, r, g, b, /get IDL> tiff_write, fname, array, red = r, green = g, blue = b
```

This assumes that you have used LOADCT or XLOADCT to load the appropriate color table first.
