- > I am running IDL on a Sparc 10 using SunOS. Here's the problem:
- > We increased the ram in our machine to let us make longer animations,
- > but IDL crashes after ~370 frames, which is what it did before the
- > additional memory. When it crashes, it has only used ~63Mb of RAM
- > (~33%), and it posts the following error message:
- > XIO: fatal IO error 32 (Broken pipe) on X server ":0.0"
- > after 71519 requests (71517 known processed) with 0 events remaining.
- > The connection was probably broken by a server shutdown or KillClient.

- > I will be extremely grateful to any suggestions as to possible solutions.

Do you have per-process memory limitations in place? I am not familiar with SunOS, but Unixes I have used allow such things.
