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Does anyone know how to access parts of structures in IDL? Looking up the version of IDL, I can type:

```
IDL> print,!version
{ sparc sunos 3.6.1}
```

I can't directly access the individual components, since a help will give:

```
IDL> help,!version
<Expression>  STRUCT  = -> !VERSION Array(1)
```

Messier is figuring out what the individual components are called, which will give string outputs:

```
IDL> print,!version.arch
sparc
IDL> print,!version.os
sunos
IDL> print,!version.release
3.6.1
```

My question is then how would I pull out what I need to know from !version if I didn't know the names for the individual components (i.e., "!version.arch", "!version.os")? Is there a command that can pull out what I need, like this example below?

```
IDL> print,MYSTERY_COMMAND(!version,0)
sparc
```
