> These widgets shall be centered or left- or right aligned, but
> the keyword work only with the /COLUMN keyword with strange
> looking results.

If you have specified the /ALIGN_CENTER keyword in the WIDGET_BASE() call when you create the base widget that is the parent for your widgets in the row, then your widgets should be centered.

An alternative is to use the /BASE_ALIGN_CENTER keyword when you create the widget base that is the "parent of the parent" of your row widgets. This often works well if you have a column-based group of widgets, and within that you want to have a row-based sub-group, but would like to have everything centered.

Hope this makes sense.
