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I think that I have found a bug in the str_sep.pro function. Observe the following:

```
IDL> t = 'apples, oranges, peaches'
IDL> print, str_sep(t, ',')
apples oranges , peaches
IDL> print, str_sep(t, ', ')
apples oranges nges, peaches
```

It appears that the last element is messed up when you add the space to the separator it fails on the last element.
