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I have some IDL widget-based applications that I developed on an SGI Indigo 2 Impact 10000, running IRIX 6.2. The applications look good when I use a Linux box, Mac or HP as a front end to the SGI, but when I sit down at the SGI and run the applications, the fonts in the widgets and graphics windows are way too huge and the colors in the graphics windows are terrible. I found a way to tame the colors (adding some lines to .Xdefaults), but I cannot find a way to control the fonts. Does anyone know how to ensure vector-drawn fonts look good (and similar) across different X11 servers?
