> thought that I could use contour again, with the c_orientation and over
> keywords set. However, apparently I need the cell_fill keyword to
> create the proper contours, and thus the overplotting contour call wipes
> out my original contour plot.

> Does anyone know of a way to do this or has code?

Uh, I reckon I'd try it t'other way round. Draw the hatched contour plot, then overplot (or use NOERASE) the original contour plot on top of that.
