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Hello,

I am using IDL 5.0 under Solaris 2.5 with emacs 19.34 and idl-shell v2.1.

The shell worked very nicely with IDL 4.0.1, but IDL 5.0 introduces a problem: When a breakpoint is reached, IDL splits the line at column 79, breaking the filename as in this example.

```
% Breakpoint at: MREF_PROJECTIONS 552 /export/home/dave/src/smis/seq/sepi/rec
on/sepi_read.pro
```

Naturally, idl-shell.el hasn't anticipated this, and tries to open a file named 'rec'.

I tried setting the dumb terminal width to 132, but this doesn't affect IDL's behavior. Has anyone found a good workaround?
