Richard G. French wrote:

- > I have recently upgraded to IDL5.0 on a DEC Alpha running OSF. I have
- > created some save files that contain variables ONLY (NOT any routines,
- > NO system variables, and only some explicitly listed variables) using
- > a command such as

>

> save, file=savefilename, variable1, variable2, etc....

>

- > I then ported this file by binary ftp to a Sun workstation running
- > IDL4.0 and tried to restore the savefile. I get 'Unexpected item code'
- > and then IDL crashes.

Yes, what you did is supposed to work, and if IDL really crashes then this is a *serious* bug in IDL V5.0. Interestingly, when I go the opposite direction (save with IDL5.0 on Sun workstation and restore with IDL4.0 on a DEC Alpha/OSF) then I also get the 'Unexpected item code' message, but the restore seems to work. Anybody able to test SAVE/RESTORE between IDL5.0 Sun and IDL5.0 Alpha/OSF?

I would hope that RSI would have a bug-fix release of V5.0 in the not-too-distant future.
