I am looking for a routine that will take as input an array that is essentially a pixmap of a plot (ie: someone scanned a plot of data into an array) and will output an x and y array of values of the plotted data. Presumably the pixmap will be a plot of only one dataset, and I guess you may have to input some increment number that would define how many points of data will be taken from the plotted data line.
