You can create multiple window 'frames' using my frame tools available at <http://cimss.ssec.wisc.edu/~gumley/frame.html>

All plot parameters are saved for each frame. You can even save the frames to a platform independent SAVE file which can then be reloaded during a future IDL session on the same platform, or any other platform that runs the same version of IDL.
