Until then:

Why is the first one of the following two statements perfectly fine while the second one gives arithmetic errors and no map whatsoever?

1:

```
map_set, 37, -73, /mercator, /hires, /grid, limit = [34, -77, 40,-71],$  
      label = 2
```

2:

```
map_set, 37, -73, /mercator, /hires, /grid, limit = [35, -75, 39, -71],$  
      label = 2
```

What are the limitations of the mercator projections?
