It would sure make a lot of people happy if the event from a Droplist widget would include the text of the selected choice (this is what I'm assuming you mean by "element"). Most people create an array of choices, use it to create the Droplist widget, and then store it in the widget's info structure so you can use the EVENT.INDEX from the droplist event to index this array in your event handler.
