
Subject: YTITLE behaviour in Mac IDL?

I noticed something a bit strange today. The command

PLOT, findgen(100), YTITLE='Test'

on our workstations using 5.1 plots up fine, with the entire title "Test" parallel to the y axis (e.g. the characters are perpendicular to the Y axis, but the word runs parallel to the Y axis). The same thing with IDL 5.1 for PowerMac, yields the title "Test" running like a banner along the Y axis, so that both the characters AND the word are parallel to the Y axis:
