IDL does NOT perform multitasking. When you write a Widget\_Control, Timer=... command, you are actually inserting a request to IDL to queue an event on the event stack at the time indicated. When IDL notices that the time has been reached, it puts the event on the event stack, and calls your handler when all previous events have been handled.
