> pro B

> COMMON SHARE1

> X.a = 4 ; this is not permitted

> X.b = 5

> end

> Does anyone know how to resolve this problem ?

You need a structure definition statement following the
COMMON declaration:

pro A

COMMON SHARE1, X ;how to define x as a structure ?

x = {A:0, B:0}

;~~~~~

;

X.a = 1

X.b = 2

end

pro B

COMMON SHARE1

X.a = 4 ; this is not permitted

X.b = 5

end

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
